CHOOSING YOUR ARCTIC ADVENTURE

Stretching across the top of the globe and touching eight countries, the Arctic is rife with opportunity for every type of explorer. National Geographic-Lindblad Expeditions offers 19 itineraries in this remote part of the world, each providing a unique point of view on the region. Here are some highlights to help you decide which expedition is the best fit for your interests.

SVALBARD & NORWAY

Explore Svalbard's wild icy shores in the early season to spot walruses, reindeer and the icon of the Arctic—the polar bear. In the Norwegian fjords, kayak and cruise beneath soaring cliffs and tumbling cascades. These breathtaking regions are ideal for photographers.

Best for: epic wildlife, iconic scenery, photography

ICELAND & THE FAROE ISLANDS

Encounter the living Earth in Iceland as you Zodiac cruise around basalt islands, hike to a thundering waterfall or stroll cliffs aflutter with gannets and puffins. In the Faroe Islands, discover the threads connecting the Vikings to modern Arctic communities.

Best for: geology, birdlife, active exploration

GREENLAND

An emerging destination for adventure travel, Greenland's glittering icescapes and dynamic tundra converge in a dazzling Arctic tableau best explored by kayak and Zodiac or on foot. Go beyond the country's icy surface to experience cultural encounters in vibrant Inuit communities.

Best for: dramatic fjords, Arctic culture, backcountry exploration

CANADA

Canada is home to the legendary Northwest Passage, ideal for the explorer who seeks seldom-seen lands and their near mythic creatures—polar bears, walruses and belugas. Further south, engage with vibrant maritime communities.

Best for: big ice, rare wildlife, Inuit culture
