Our Hands-On Program for Kids and Teens

Established in collaboration with National Geographic Education, our exclusive family programs are designed to nurture the next generation of global stewards out in the natural world. National Geographic Global Explorers program is offered in Alaska, Baja California, Galápagos, and on our Journey to Antarctica: The White Continent expedition, and our new itineraries Quest for the Antarctic Circle, Antarctica Direct: Fly the Drake Passage, and Antarctica Direct: Sail and Fly the Drake Passage. In Iceland we offer National Geographic Expeditions Adventurers Program. Kids and teens aged 18 and under learn how to explore like scientists as they hone their observation skills and capture their experiences through photographs, videos, drawings, and more. With a range of activities to choose from all led by National Geographic certified field educators, it provides a stress-free, rewarding way for families to explore the world together.











PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Wildlife Watching

Hop into a Zodiac, zip along the shore, and hike in search of wildlife and interesting plant life. Snap photos and jot notes in your official National Geographic Global Explorers Field Notebook.

Microscopic Exploration

Drop a net over the side of your Zodiac to collect plankton, then check it under a video microscope to see how it looks and moves.

Video Shoots

Meet your certified photo instructor in the lounge and get tips on how to create impressive slow-motion and timelapse videos, then test out those skills in the field.

Check Your List

Meet in the lounge to go over all the wildlife you saw and mark it in your field notebook. Add the day's points to your tally so you can keep track of your progress to earn your official certificate as a National Geographic Global Explorer.

New Friends and Fun Adventures

Meet up with your new friends for fun activities with your certified field educator like a pizza dinner, a special National Geographic Global Explorers hike, or other surprises.

Night Sky

Head to the top deck to watch the stars come out as the sun goes down. Find new constellations with the help of your naturalists and make notes of them. (When conditions allow.)
